How to use the Sanctuary Prayer Guide

The Sanctuary Prayer Guide is a tool to guide you in daily worship with the Lord. Here's a step-by-step tutorial on how to put it to the best use.

- 1.** Dedicate a block of time to daily worship with Christ. Note: It takes about an hour to go through the entire prayer guide.
- 2.** Find a quiet space. Set up your personal prayer corner, closet, or whatever space you use for your worship time. Make sure that you have a space dedicated for just you and God during this time.
- 3.** Create a prayer binder. Your prayer binder should include the Sanctuary Prayer Guide, pens, pencils, markers, and whatever else you need to take notes.
- 4.** Have your Bible and concordance ready.
- 5.** You're ready to go! Let's get started!

The Sanctuary Prayer Method



Seven Aspects of Sanctuary Prayer

STEP 1. GATE-PRAISE

Praise God from whom all blessings flow! Praise God in whatever song, scripture, or words of personal gratitude that are appropriate for the day.

Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise
Psalm 100:4

STEP 2. ALTAR OF SACRIFICE-HUMILITY & CONFESSION

Lay down your life to God. Confess your sins, attitudes, beliefs, unforgiveness, and anything that is contrary to the word of God. Ask to be healed and forgiven. Rom 12:1,2, 6:6-14, Cor 15:31, Luke 9:23,24.

Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!
John 1:29

STEP 3. LAVER-CLEANSING

Ask God to renew and heal your mind. Wash your mind with the water of the word. Look up Bible texts to confirm the truth to reverse the lies you've believed. Complete a word study using your concordance. Look up words such as honesty, strife, faith, love, anger, etc.

To make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word, and to present her to himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless.
Ephesians 5:25,26

STEP 4. SEVEN BRANCH CANDLESTICK-THE HOLY SPIRIT

Ask to receive the Holy Spirit and the seven spirits of God. Ask for the fruits of the spirit according to Galatians 5:22-33.

*Before the throne, seven lamps were blazing.
These are the seven Spirits of God.*

Revelation 4:5

STEP 5. TABLE OF SHEWBREAD-THE WORD OF GOD

Live, as Jesus did, on every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God. Meditate on the word of Jesus. Look up Bible texts, specifically the new testament.

*I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry,
and he who believes in me will never be thirsty.*

John 6:35

STEP 6. ALTAR OF INCENSE-INTERCESSION

Pray without ceasing. Pray for those whom the Lord lays upon your heart. You can follow the sanctuary steps on their behalf if you desire. This seems to be a very effective and powerful way to bring a person before the Lord. You can also place your requests before the Lord, and claim the promises of the word of God for that person.

*He was given much incense to offer, with the prayers of all the saints, on the golden altar before
the throne. The smoke of the incense, together with the prayers of the saints, went up before
God from the angel's hand.*

Revelation 8:3,4


STEP 7. ARK OF THE COVENANT-COMPLETE CONNECTION TO CHRIST

Jesus will write his law on the tablets of your heart and mind. The Mercy Seat contains the 10 Commandments and the law of God.

*I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you; I will remove from you your heart of stone
and give you a heart of flesh. And I will put my Spirit in you and move you to follow my decrees
and be careful to keep my laws.*

I am thankful for salvation, and your righteousness that is imparted to me. I am thankful for the Holy Spirit. Thank you for sanctifying me with your word. Thank you for your peace that surpasses all understanding. Thank you for every battle and every problem I face because I know that each battle is an opportunity to gain victory. I know that I will overcome with you, Lord. Thank you for revealing the roots in my heart that don't align with your character. I know that the trying of my faith produces patience, and I want to let patience have its perfect work in my life. Thank you for your provisions, as you supply all my needs according to your riches in glory. Thank you for healing the past, present, and future. I thank you for being my divine healer physically, emotionally, mentally, and spiritually.

Thank you for allowing me to hear, see, touch, taste, and smell. Thank you for nature and the wonderful things you created for me. Thank you for being present with me always. Thank you for the fruits of the spirit which are love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, gentleness, meekness, and self-control. I thank you, Lord, for your seven spirits: wisdom, knowledge, understanding, power, fear of the Lord, counsel, and righteous judgment. The Altar of Sacrifice

Humility & Confession

PART 1: HUMILITY

Lord, thank you for the sacrifice that you paid for me to have special communion and personal time with you each day. Thank you for your sacrifice and for choosing to give your life to make me free from sin. I am grateful that I have complete access to you and that I can talk directly to you. Help me to never take for granted the price that you paid to save me from sin. Help me Lord to never take your word for granted and to follow you in all your ways.

Lord, I give my heart and my all to you today. I want to be healed and made free from all bondage and sin. I want to be, think and act like you. Help me to be willing to sacrifice anything to please you and come into agreement with you in any area of my life. Make me willing and able to be and think like you. If there is any area where I have unknowingly sinned I ask that you give me the desire to see your truth and come into alignment with you in this area.

Lord my righteousness is of filthy rags and I need to be made clean. I want to overcome any sin that so easily besets me, this includes the lies I believe about you, myself, and others. I want and desire to have your fruits of the spirit bear witness in my life. I am asking that you purify my mind in a special way. Please reveal my faulty character and make me new in the inward parts of my heart. Give me understanding and open my eyes to see things the way that you see them. I give you complete permission over my life today and I ask that you renew my heart, Lord.

Is there anything in particular that you need to give to Jesus?

For he who had died has been freed from sin.

PART 2: CONFESSION

Give God your sins, the memories of sins from the past, your hurts, resentments, fears, or any negative thoughts, feelings, or character traits that God brings to your mind.

Give God the lies that you have believed as a result of the sins, memories, hurts, and resentments. Refer to the lie list and sin list on pages 19-24.

Lord, I give you sovereign control over me, and I ask for mercy and forgiveness for my sins by which I have grieved you. Jesus, I ask that you meet the full penalty that my sins deserve. I resist all of Satan's activity to hold me in blindness and darkness. I renounce all the sins of my ancestors. Jesus, I ask you to cancel out all demonic work that has been passed on to me from my ancestors. I ask you to cancel every curse that may have been put on me. I renounce any and every way in which Satan may claim ownership over me. I declare myself to be eternally and completely signed over and committed to you, Lord. I do this in the name and authority of you Jesus.

Lord, I ask that you cover my sins with your precious blood, and cleanse and remove the sins from my amygdala. I ask that you please cleanse my memories of each sin and lie. Cleanse my books in heaven where the sin is recorded, and cover me with your robe of righteousness. Jesus, I ask you to cast out all demons associated with the sin, send them to the abyss, and bind them there for the day of judgment, never to return.

Jesus, I pull down the strongholds that the kingdom of darkness has formed against me. I destroy all the plans formed against my mind, my will, and my body. I destroy in prayer the spiritual blindness and deafness that Satan has had on me. I invite you Lord to bring the fullness of your power to convict, to bring to repentance, and to lead me into faith in you, Jesus. I ask you to cover me with your blood. Break Satan's power to blind me to your truth. I believe Lord, that your Holy Spirit is leading me. I give myself unreservedly to you and I thank you for answering my prayer. I joyfully lay this prayer before you and I believe that he who began a good work in me is faithful to complete it.

Then I acknowledged my sin to you and did not cover up my iniquity. I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the Lord." And you forgave the guilt of my sin. Therefore let all the faithful pray to you while you may be found: surely the rising of the mighty waters will not reach them. You are my hiding place: you will protect me from trouble and surround me with songs of deliverance.

The Laver

Cleansing

Lord, only you are worthy and mighty. Only you can make me whole. You have etched me in my mother's womb. You created me and only you can recreate me because you are the Lord of my life, and you are the Lord of my mind. Lord, I have believed things that are not true, and I now ask to be filled with the truth of your precious character. You are good I can only be good through you. Set ablaze healing in my mind. I ask that you remove connections in my brain that are tied to old ways of thinking and form new neural pathways with your truth.

Lord, sanctify my mind in your name and help me to submit and surrender every area of my mind to your word. Flood my mind with your presence, Jesus. I ask that you please cover each access point in my mind so that the enemy has no entrance! Lord, I declare that my thoughts and mind have been given to you, and I give you complete permission to restore my mind. I ask that you heal my mind so that no entry point is accessible to the enemy. Your word says that if I resist the devil he has to flee. Lord, I am resisting him now in this area and asking that you take complete control. Lord, help me to submit and completely surrender to your truth.

Lord, recreate me according to the original plan that you wrote for me in your books. Fill my heart to receive your truth and replace all the lies that I've believed with your truth. I ask that you download your thoughts (about the incident and the wrongdoer) into my mind. Show me evidence from your word of who you are. Lord, change my heart and make me clean. Wash me Lord, and I will be whiter than snow. Clean the parts in my heart that are impure and make me your spotless bride.

Write out specific Bible promises to reverse the lies you've believed.

The Holy Spirit

Lord, thank you for dying for me and for cleansing me from all sin. I am thankful for your blood that protects, cleanses, heals, delivers, sanctifies, redeems, justifies, and makes all things new in every area of my life. I want to be your spotless bride. I want to be holy and without blemish. You are my sanctifier, and I want to be your humble servant, to walk in love, forgiveness, and gentleness toward others. Lord, help me to die from all self-desires and live to do what only pleases you.

I ask that you help me to not be deceived in any area and follow you. Set a clear path before me. Please fill me with your Holy Spirit, wisdom, understanding, knowledge, power, and counsel. Lord, help me to fear you with a Holy fear so that I will follow your law. Lord, I ask that you please allow me to fully operate in who you are. I ask that you please speak to me and help me to hear your voice. I pray that my life may become saturated with you Jesus, that people don't see me anymore, but see you in me, for your praise and glory.

Lord, I pray that your love may shine forth in me so strongly no matter how I am treated. Help me to not feel slighted or take offense to others but to cover others with your love because your love covers a multitude of sin. I ask that your peace and joy would abide within me today. Teach me to be patient and kind in all my dealings with others and manifest the goodness and grace in me that only comes from you. Help me to be gentle and self-controlled in my actions and attitudes. Help me Lord to be temperate in all things. I want to be a faithful servant for you Lord. Help me to remain faithful in all things. Lord, I know that I cannot develop the fruit of your Holy Spirit through my own effort or will, but only as I rest in you, Jesus. Help me to abide in you I pray.

Have mercy on me, O God, according to your unfailing love; according to your great compassion blot out my transgressions. Wash away all my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin.

For I know my transgressions, and my sin is always before me. Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight; so you are right in your verdict and justified when you judge.

Surely I was sinful at birth, sinful from the time my mother conceived me. Yet you desired faithfulness even in the womb; you taught me wisdom in that secret place.

Cleanse me with hyssop, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow. Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones you have crushed rejoice. Hide your face from my sins and blot out all my iniquity.

Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me. Then I will teach transgressors your ways, so that sinners will turn back to you.

Deliver me from the guilt of bloodshed, O God, you who are God my Savior, and my tongue will sing of your righteousness. Open my lips, Lord, and my mouth will declare your praise.

Lord, I know that my battle is not with flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Therefore, I put on the whole armor of God, so that I may be able to withstand in the evil day. I want to be a pillar for you. I now ask that you work deep in my heart so that I may connect deeply with you.

Lord, your words are true and established in heaven. Please give me faith to receive your word and to walk in your truth. Lord, help me to be a doer of your word. May your word be a lamp unto my feet, a light unto my path. My soul needs nourishment from you and you alone. Help me to digest your word. Pour the truth from your word into my mind and make it real in my life.

PRAYER POINTS:

Lord Jesus, you are the covering cherub over my family, church, finances, business, job, and possessions. Jesus, you are Lord over my life, and where your power and presence are sicknesses, poverty, and death can't remain.

I ask for your protection wherever I go today. I ask that you protect my home. I ask that you cover all who enter and all who exit my home. A city on a hill cannot be hidden. Help me Lord so that I do not hide my light under a bushel, but will let my light shine before men so that they may see my good works and glorify you. Help me to be a light to those I see and communicate with today. I thank you for my ministry. I ask that you allow my ministry to be a blessing to others.

Lord, you are merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and bountiful in mercy. You have not dealt with me according to my iniquities. As far as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is your mercy toward those who fear you. Lord, I ask that you open the doors so that my family and friends will be free from any bondage and strongholds in their lives. Help each of them to depend completely on you today with their life. Lord save those in my life who do not have a relationship with you. Send angels from your throne to speak to their hearts.

Lord help my family and friends to hear and obey your voice. Lead them and guide them today and keep them from walking in the counsel of the ungodly, or standing in the way of sinners, or sitting at the seat of the scornful. Help my family and friends to walk according to your word. Lord, help them to acknowledge you in everything they do. I claim and believe that all things in their path will bring glory to you. Lord, I ask that you open a divine appointment for me today to share your love.

Lord, please allow your Spirit to lead us (my family, friends, church, etc.), as you are Jehovah Rohi, our shepherd according. Instruct us and teach us in the way we should go. Guide us with your eye. Lord, please guide us into all truth. Teach us all things, and help us to remember all things you have taught us according to your word. Give us the boldness to stand up for you. Help us to make disciples for you. Lord lead us so that the message of victory goes all over the world.

I ask you to make your word stronger and greater than our will. I ask you to make us hunger and thirst after your righteousness. I stand on your promises that (list children, family, etc.) will be powerful pillars of truth for you. Help my family, friends, and loved ones to keep a pure heart according to your word. Help them to remember your promises. Help them to know that you will never leave or forsake them. Lord, I ask that you please bless them with your righteousness, protect them, surround them and be their shield. Lord, help them to dwell in your secret place and abide under your shadow. Cover them and heal them from all mental, physical and spiritual sickness and disease.

May the Lord answer you when you are in distress; may the name of the God of Jacob protect you. May he send you help from the sanctuary and grant you support from Zion. May he remember all your sacrifices and accept your burnt offerings. May he give you the desire of your heart and make all your plans succeed. May we shout for joy over your victory and lift up our banners in the name of our God. May the Lord grant all your requests.
